As the weather turns cooler, the South Bend Fire Department wants to remind residents that smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are the best ways to keep family members safe.

In addition to changing batteries on the alarms each fall and spring, as we change our clocks, it's also a good time to check the age of your alarms. Alarms more than 10 years old should be replaced.

It's also a great time of year for residents to become mentors. The Big Brothers Big Sisters of St. Joseph County (bbbs-sjc.org or 232-9958) and the South Bend Education Foundation's Mentoring Matters Program (edfo.org/mentoring or 283-8072) deserve our community's support for the great work they do to help young people.
