
Gentlemen:

On November 9, 1964 the Board of Works and Safety directed that a study be made reference need for prohibiting trucks from using an alley south of Lincoln Way West from an alley west of Kuntsman Court to Scott Street.

Conditions are not unlike situations in similar type alleys and prohibition of trucks would deprive other businesses in the vicinity of service. Also it was learned that the trucks previously using this alley have transferred their loading and unloading operations to the rear of 406 N. Scott Street thereby using a north south alley.

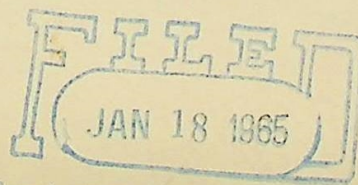
Observations will continue and further recommendations will be made if necessary.

On November 9, 1964 at the regular meeting of the Board, a hearing was scheduled for Vacation Resolution No. 3113 (alley south of Lincoln Way West from alley west of Kunstman Court to Scott Street.)

The following is a part of the record concerning this Vacation:

Came now Joseph Fischhoff, Petitioner and advises the Board that he desires this alley closed due to the fact that it is very narrow and serves no purpose as an alley since trucks which enter, mostly by mistake, have damaged his building and pulled off downspouts from Basic Machine in an effort to negotiate a turn out of this alley. Mr. Fischhoff further explained that it is not necessary to use this alley for delivery to his building or Basic Machine.

After hearing Mr. Fischhoff, the Board was advised by the City Engineer and the Fire Chief that both were opposed to this vacation since the Fire Department would have no access to the rear of Basic Machine if this alley were vacated. This is in the No. One Fire District and there have been several fires at Basic Machine.

The Board suggested to Mr. Fischhoff that since the main objection to the alley was because of damage to his building from trucks, a sign "Trucks Prohibited" posted on this alley might solve the problem.

The Board ruled that this be referred to the Traffic Engineer for survey and report with his recommendation on November 16, 1964.

No report has been received to date.

At the meeting of January 11, 1965, an Assessment Roll was filed by the City Engineer for this Vacation, which Assessment Roll will be advertised with hearing set for February 8, 1965.
