

P E T I T I O N

The Petitioner shows to the Board of Public Works and Safety:

1. That it is a non-profit corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana.
2. That it is the owner of Lots 1 through 26, inclusive, as shown on the recorded Plat of Timothy E. Howard's Sub-division of Out Lot 8 in Samuel L. Cottrell's First Addition to the Town of Lowell, now a part of the City of South Bend, St. Joseph County, Indiana.
3. That said lots constitute all of the lots on both sides of the following described alleys and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, which alleys were laid out when said addition was platted:
 - a. The alley running East and West between Lots 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 on the North and Lots 22, 24, 25, and 26 on the South in said Sub-division.
 - b. The alley running East and West between Lots 23, 24, 25, and 26 and 13, on the North, and Lots 1 and 12 on the South in said Sub-division.
 - c. The alley running East and West between Lots 2 and 11 on the North, and Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 on the South in said Sub-division.
 - d. The alley running North and South between Lots 17 and 26 on the West and 13, 14, and 16 on the East in said Sub-division.
4. That petitioner believes that the formal vacation of said alley will be of public and private benefit.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that said alleys be vacated.
