Bill No. 24-16 — Declaratory Resolution Real Property Tax Abatement 728 Harrison Avenue — Cross Community, Inc

Mark Bemenderfer, Business Development Manager, with offices on the 14th floor of the County-City Building, stated that Bill *No. <u>24-16</u>* is a five (5) year single -family residential real property tax abatement for property located at 728 Harrison Avenue. The petitioner is Cross Community Inc., and they provide homeownership information to first (1st) time homebuyers. Cross Community is planning to invest two hundred and seventy thousand dollars (\$270,000) for the development of a new two (2) story home.

Tina Patton, President of Cross Community, with offices located at 707 Sherman Avenue, South Bend IN 46616, stated that Bill *No. <u>24-16</u>* is the third (3rd) tax abatement Cross Community has requested. Tina Patton stated that Cross Community is committed to redeveloping the northwest part of South Bend for residents seeking homes at an affordable price.

Committee Member Bolden-Simpson motioned to send Bill *No. <u>24-16</u>* to the Committee of the Whole with a favorable recommendation, which was seconded by Committee Member Gooden-Rodgers and carried by a vote of five (5) ayes with one (1) committee member absent.
