Committee Chair Wax called to order the Health & Public Safety meeting at 3:35 p.m.

Bill No. 22-33 — Resolution re: Appointment of FOP Negotiation Team

Councilmember Niezgodski advised that the resolution is the same as the previous regotiation. The resolution outlines the team Council members and identifies attorney Bob Palmer as an agent and/or negotiator.

Bob Palmer advised that in collective bargaining sessions with the city, employees, and teamsters, the Council is represented by a panel of three (3) negotiators: the Council President, a chief negotiator, and an agent who has historically been the Council attorney. The team holds an advisory role and reports back to the Council on the negotiation discussions to be considered for the budget process. The budget must be approved by the Council.

Bill No. 22-34 — Scrap Metal
